

You will be provided with a document that should be carried with you and can be produced if requested by an Education Department official or Police Officer. Remember that regular attendance at school is essential to assist students to maximise their potential.

**Uniform** – with the cold mornings students still need to come to school dressed in full school uniform each day. Please assist your child in locating their belongings and naming them. Remember that students can purchase beanies and warm jackets through the office in preparation for the cold and windy winter days ahead.

Premiers Sporting Challenge -Over the next few weeks all students will begin the Premier's Primary School Sport Challenge which aims to engage young people in sport and physical activity and encourages them to lead healthy, active lifestyles. The Premier's Primary School Sport Challenge involves primary school classes participating in a 10 week sport and physical activity challenge. A class may accumulate time spent in a broad range of sports and recreational pursuits during lunchtime, in school sport programs, class time, after school or in weekend physical activity.
